Christmas waste

Please recycle as much of your Christmas waste as possible.

Wrapping paper, plastic packaging, carrier bags, crackers, greeting cards and cardboard can all go in your green recycling bin, along with empty food or drink bottles, cans, cartons and foil.

To help create more space in your bin please flatten any boxes or packaging, and remove the tops from bottles and squash those down.

But don't worry if you create more recycling and fill your green bin, you can put extra recycling out for collection next to your bin in clear sacks, carrier bags or cardboard boxes.

Garden waste collections over Christmas

There will be no brown bin collections from garden waste customers over the Christmas holidays as per your terms and conditions.

This is so crews can concentrate on collecting the extra household waste during this period when there's very little garden waste. This year there will be no garden waste collections between Wednesday 28 December and Tuesday 3 January. Collections will start again on Tuesday 10 January. We will however collect extra garden waste during the week of 19 March. The extra waste should be no more than an extra brown bin load, should be able to be lifted by one person and should be in either a sturdy box or bag, which must be left open.

What happens if collections are disrupted?

Occasionally bad weather such as snow or flooding can mean it is unsafe for our waste vehicles or their crews to be on the roads and pavements and we have to cancel collections.

If collections are cancelled we will let people know by issuing regular updates on our website www.southoxon.gov.uk and to our waste text subscribers, as well as via the local media and parish councils in the district. You can also call 03000 610610 to get the latest information. If collections are cancelled crews will pick up any extra rubbish or recycling the next time this waste is due to be collected.

Sacks instead of bins?

You should have a new supply of sacks for 2012 (please call 03000 610610 if you haven't received them yet). Please follow the calendar, and if it's a green week put out your green recycling sacks and a grey week your pink rubbish sacks.

Got extra recycling?

You can put extra recycling out next to your green bin in clear or opaque sacks, carrier bags or cardboard boxes.

Want a free reminder if collections change?

You can get free text message reminders when collections change due to bank holidays or bad weather. To register send a text with the word waste and your collection day (for example waste Monday) to 07797 870370.
